ADVERTISEMENT "What we're seeing in these areas is not only [the] Taliban, but local support for them," Army Maj. Gen. Scott Miller, commander of the Afghan National Army's 1st Corps, told reporters in Kabul, Afghanistan, on Aug. 17. "I don't know what will be in the future and what will be developed." The senior military commander acknowledged that local support is helping the Taliban. "They're feeding the Taliban when the military is in the villages," he said. Sgt. Maj. Darrel L. Armstrong, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers spokesman, confirmed that coalition troops have increased their support to the local communities. "The U.S. and Coalition forces have been meeting with the local leadership in these communities to better understand their needs," he said. "The number of joint operations conducted this past year shows these actions are paying off in Afghanistan." But such actions have only extended to select regions in the country, according to other military officials. "In a lot of cases we've worked in particular communities to build trust with the tribes and in some cases we've also met with the tribes and helped build bridges with the Taliban," said one Army official, who spoke to The Hill on condition of anonymity because of the sensitivity of the subject. "We've met with them, educated them and provided them training on security and economic development. We've been successful in a few places, but it's still in the early stages," he added.
